Community Art Installation
At the Scottish Crannog Centre, Loch Tay



Over the last 3 years The Scottish Crannog Centre has been on a journey, through trials and tribulations, a fire, a flood, and a worldwide pandemic. After the fire in 2021, we thanked our lucky stars no one was hurt, gathered our belongings and began to plan our move to a new home. Throughout this, we have been blessed with support from so many people, an armada of log boats came to our rescue offering skills, knowledge and love.

As we open the doors to our new museum, built from 1000 fingerprints and designed by 100 voices, we invite you to celebrate this with us through the installation of a new public artwork on the shore of Loch Tay.

Come together with the Crannog Centre to celebrate a special person or moment, in your life, by having it celebrated in a new Lochside work of art by Angus Ross. By donating £250 to support the charitable work of the Crannog Centre, you can have a glass disc with your words included in this open-air sculpture. The sculpture is made by master craftsmen in Aberfeldy out of local oak. The work has been commissioned from award-winning local designer Angus Ross, who took inspiration from the ethos and work of the Scottish Crannog Centre, reflecting the ideas of working together, community, interconnections and togetherness. It is also inspired by the structural details of the woven roundhouse and the upright supports of the original Crannogs. From this inspiration he has created a work of strong verticals in a split and steam-bent oak frame, incorporating round transparent discs at the heart of each pillar that can be personalised and engraved with messages and memories from all our supporters. Slowly this will build a beautiful monument for people to come together and celebrate the events and memories that the discs mark.

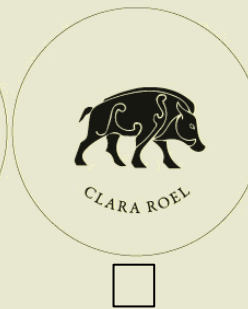
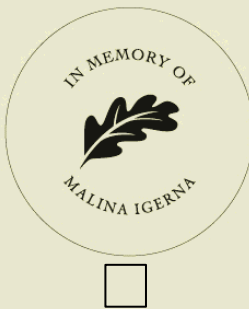
